#### What is the Topeka Neighborhood Dreams Fund Program Grant?

The Topeka Neighborhood Dreams Fund program provides mini-grants, technical assistance and other support to NIAs for community engagement and small neighborhood based public projects or local match funds for larger public projects..

\$200,000 (\$140,000 (GO Bonds) and \$60,000 from (CDBG) is available to award grants ranging from \$2,000 up to \$100,000.

*Eligible Project Activities*: Public Improvements, Public Accessibility, Public Infrastructure, Neighborhood Beautification, Community Engagement
