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3 A RESOLUTION introduced by Interim City Manager Richard U. Nienstedt supporting
4 the City of Topeka's application for funding from the Kansas
5 Department of Transportation for Topeka Bikeways Phase V
6 implementation.
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8 WHEREAS, the City desires to submit an application to the Kansas Department of
9 Transportation for Transportation Alternatives Program funds afforded by the Fixing
10 America's Surface Transportation Act; and

11 WHEREAS, the application would advance implementation of the Topeka
12 Bikeways Master Plan and its supplemental plan (Bikeways Circulation Study) as recently
13 approved by the Metropolitan Topeka Planning Organization (MTPO) policy board; and

14 WHEREAS, after appropriate input from the MTPO's Complete Streets Advisory
15 Committee and staff, the Governing Body supports submission of an application for
16 funding the following projects of the Bikeways Phase V implementation:

17 • SE Adams Street – one-way separated bike facilities and lane reduction and other
18 speed management measures from SE 10th Avenue to SE 1st Street

19 • SW 4th Street – one-way separated bike facilities and lane reduction and other
20 speed management measures from Washburn Avenue to Kansas Avenue

21 • SW 5th Street – one-way parking protected separated bike facilities and lane
22 reduction and other speed management measures from Washburn Avenue to SE 4th
23 Street.

24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE
25 CITY OF TOPEKA, KANSAS, that:

26 Section 1. The Governing Body authorizes the City Manager to submit an
27 application to the Kansas Department of Transportation for transportation alternatives

28 program funds provided through the Fixing America’s Surface Transportation Act (FAST-
29 Act).

30 Section 2. The City assures the Kansas Department of Transportation of
31 sufficient City match requirements needed for the construction, operation, and
32 maintenance of these three projects.

33 Section 3. The City Manager is also authorized to submit additional information
34 as may be required and act as the official representative of the City in this and subsequent
35 related activities.

36 Section 4. The City assures the Kansas Department of Transportation that the
37 City is willing and able to administer the designing, letting and construction of these
38 projects, if any or all of these projects are selected for funding.

Re: Facilities Improvements, Repair and Maintenance Program Unexpected Repairs Update and Budget Requests

2 Additional projects are requested based on an emergency basis to correct deficiencies.

Fire Fleet Pump Upgrade - \$23,722; NFPA requires fire apparatus to be tested annually, current volume only allows 1,500 gallons per minute (gpm). 2016 and newer fire apparatus can flow 2,000 gpm, but current testing facilities are inadequate. Additional hose connections and 4" piping will allow testing of up to 2,000 pm.

TPAC Stage Lift Repair - \$25,909; Stage lift has water infiltrating the hydraulic lines, repair needed drain existing pump, oil lines and jacks and replace hydraulic oil in the unit.
