Opening Business

Welcome – Chairman Messina called the meeting to order with 6 members logged in for a quorum.

Approval of Minutes for May 26, 2022

Motion by Mr. Nugent to approve, second by Ms. Hiller. APPROVED 6-0-0

Public Comments - none

Action Items:

Futures 2045 (Metropolitan Transportation Plan Update Final Document: Requesting final approval for adoption

Mr. Fiander explained that the final document has been reviewed by TAC and is ready for adoption. He gave a brief review of the process, including community engagement, and provided information on the key themes: continue progress, strengthen performance management, and prepare for transportation innovations.

Ms. Hiller stated she believes great work has been done on the plan and she likes the fact that many of the proposals are fiscally constrained. Mr. Scroggins confirmed that amendments can be made to the plan as emergeing opportunities or trends come about within the timespan of the document. He noted that the plan does include aspirational projects.

Mr. Messina asked if there are performance measurements for which the MPO would like to set their own goals rather than adopting those of the state. Mr. Scroggins explained that the city and county follow their own pavement condition index and the Transportation Safety Plan is underway; a Transportation Safety Team is being formed and they will focus on creating our own safety measures.

Motion by Ms. Hiller to approve the document as presented; second by Mr. Nugent. APPROVED (6-0-0)

2021-2024 TIP Amendment #8

Mr. Scroggins reviewed the amendment and responded to questions as they arose.

a. C-5147-01: Amended Project. 26% increase in cost estimates. Bridge Replacement, 2.0 mi. E. of Elmont, over Indian Creek. (Shawnee Co.)

b. KA-6244-01: Amended Project. 36% increase in cost estimates. Mill & Overlay; K-4, beginning at the Wabaunsee/Shawnee Co. Line to Junction K-4/I-70 junction. (KDOT)

c. KA-6733-01: New Project. Multiple Bridge repairs on I-470 in Shawnee CO. (KDOT)

d. KA-6739-01: New Project. Repair Bridge #196 on US-75 in Shawnee CO. Located 0.65 mi. N. of Huntoon St. in Topeka. (KDOT)

e. KA-6740-01: New Project. Repair Bridge #154 on US-75 in Shawnee CO. Located 0.5 mi. N. of E. Junction US-75/I-70. (KDOT)

f. TMTA Operating Funding: Administrative Revision. 2022-2024 Operating expenses. (TMTA)

Motion by Ms. Hiller to forward the amendment to OneDot for inclusion into the STIP; **second** by Mr. Nugent. **APPROVED** 6-0-0

Non-Action Items:

UPWP 2022 Amendment #2 (Administrative)

Mr. Scroggins spoke about the increase in CPG funds for 2022, going from approximately \$456,000 to \$698,000. He reminded everyone that in order to spend the additional funds, a 20% local match is required. Currently un-used funds are being rolled over to next year's budget. It is unknown as to whether "claw backs" will be instituted again at some point.

Ms. Hiller asked if the additional funds could potentially be used to plan a "heritage trail". Mr. Scroggins stated that the funds could be used for planning, but not for construction or implementation. The sponsoring entity would be responsible for the 20% match.

Mr. Scroggins noted that there was an increase to the Futures 2045 consultant fee so that is now reflected in the budget.

Ms. Hiller asked Mr. Nugent if there are plans to extend transit services to the Montara and South Topeka Industrial Park area. Mr. Nugent stated that TMTA is not anticipating expanding services at this point.

Quick Updates

Ms. Wolfe reported that completion of the Deer Creek Extension is anticipated and there will be a ribbon cutting and bike ride. The City will plan to take part in this.

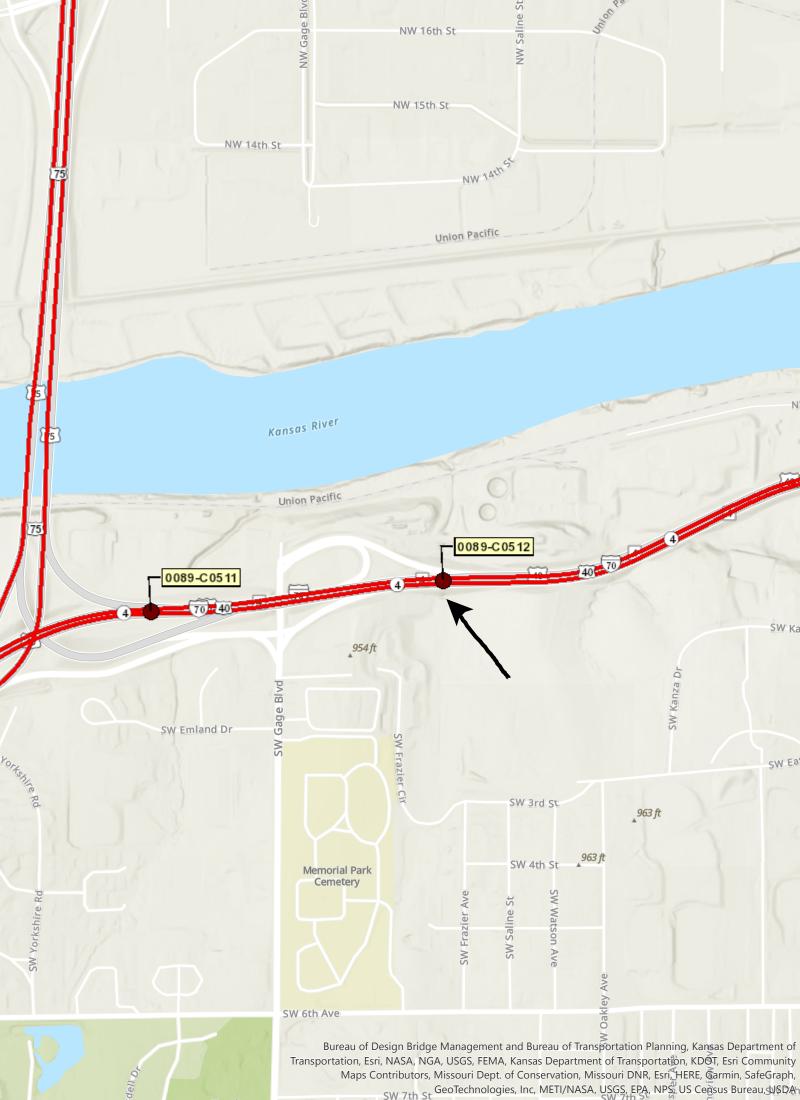

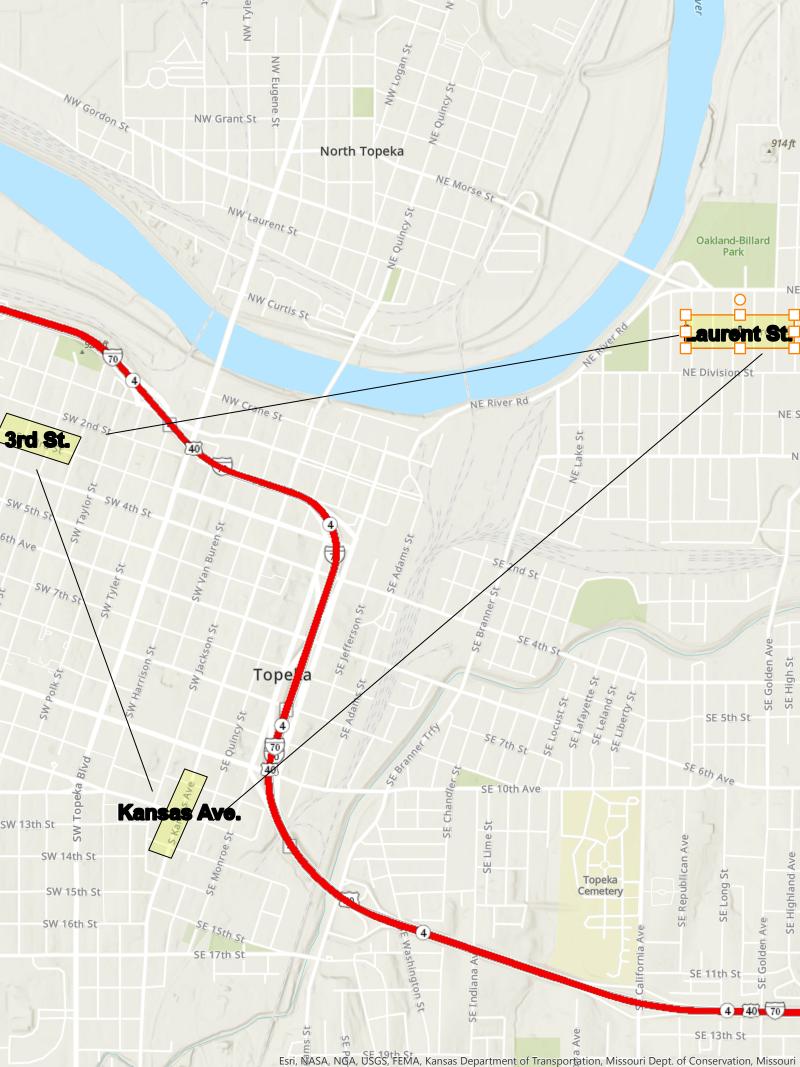
