We were awarded tentatively up to \$12,384 for the project. The review committee recommends that 501 School District provide matching funds for the remaining cost of this project. CDBG funding amounts for the 2020 Program Year have not been determined or allocated, so the amount may change. The second project was for house numbers, we were not approved. Huge thank you to Yvonne May, Wanda Bean, Leitha Dean, Danetta Stevens-Miller for your hard work preparing the applications and getting them submitted.
