Topeka Police Department Explorer Post #7721 Basic Course Information

To become a member of Police Explorer Post #7721, prospective Explorers must successfully complete the offered Basic Training course. The Basic Training Course is an 8-week course with classes held every Monday night at the Topeka Center for Advanced Learning and Careers (TCALC) from 6:30 pm to 9:00 pm. There will be a graduation ceremony upon completion.

The Basic Course is designed to educate new Explorers on the basic aspects of law enforcement that are required before attending regular Monday night Explorer training. After completion of the Basic Course, Explorers will be prepared to join Post #7721 in progressive Explorer training.

New Explorers will have strict rules to abide by during the Basic Course, which is taught by experienced officers from the Topeka Police Department. If you are interested in law enforcement you will enjoy your experience in the Basic Course. The Explorer Basic Course involves both classroom and hands on training in:

- Criminal Justice Concepts
- Investigations
- Building Search Tactics
- Effective Communication
- Field Interviews
- Dispatch
- Search and Seizure
- Physical Training

During the final week/day meeting of the Basic Course, depending on course version, the prospective Explorer will take a written examination and complete a series of evaluated law enforcement practical scenarios.

The TPD Explorer Post #7721 is proud to make this program available at no cost to the Explorer. Charter dues, competition fees, uniform/equipment costs are all covered by the Post through fundraising efforts and a supplemental budget from The Topeka Police Department.

REQUIREMENTS:

1. AGE: Must be between 14 and 20 years old and must have completed the 8th grade by the start of the Basic Course.

2. SCHOOL: If enrolled in high school or college, must maintain a grade point average of 2.0 or higher.

3. ARREST RECORD: All applicants must comply with a background investigation including, but not limited to, a criminal history records check. Any criminal history must not be excessive. There can be no felony adjudications or convictions. Any misdemeanors will be weighed on the totality of the circumstances, proximity of time to application, and considered on a case-by-case basis.

4. LETTER: Applicant should include a letter of recommendation from each of the two following categories: Personal (neighbor or family friend) and Professional (employer, coach, or teacher).

5. INTERVIEW: Must satisfactorily complete an entry interview with the Post Review Board, demonstrating the maturity level to complete the Basic Course requirements and to meet the performance standards expected of our Explorers.

6. BASIC TRAINING: Upon completion of your respective version of the Basic Course, you must be able to successfully complete the written test with a score of 80% or better.

7. EXPLORER STATUS: Upon successful completion of the Basic Course you will officially become an Explorer and begin training with the regular course.
