Insurance

A special event applicant is required to provide an original Certificate of Liability Insurance evidencing an insurance policy from an insurance company authorized to do business in the State of Kansas, which provides general liability coverage for any "special event" (as defined in TMC Section 12.70.010) in an amount not less than \$500,000 combined single limit per occurrence for bodily injury and property damage and which names the City of Topeka as an Additional Insured with the same coverage as the Insured, without restrictions.

Notwithstanding the above, a block party applicant may opt instead to execute an indemnity/hold harmless agreement, in a form approved by the City, which would indemnify and hold the City harmless against all claims, damages or causes of action arising from the event (see TMC Section 12.70.080).

To Whom it May Concern:

Preparations are underway for the 86th Annual Our Lady of Guadalupe Fiesta Mexicana. We sincerely appreciate all the assistance you have lent us in the past and look forward to working you and your department again this year. The Fiesta foods sales and carnival is set for July 16-20, 2019. The Fiesta Parade is Saturday, July 13, 2019 from 10:30 a.m. to 3:00p.m., with staging for the parade to begin at 8:00a.m.with clean up concluded by 3:00p.m. As in keeping with the last several years, we will not be hosting a Street Party in connection with the Fiesta Parade.

We have shortened the parade route by a few blocks this year. Instead of going all the way to 10^{th} street, we will be turning on 8^{th} towards Jackson and still coming back on 6^{th} street. This route has been relayed to us as the preferred choice of the Topeka Police Department and the one that every major parade in Topeka will use from here on out. In using this route, we will be implementing uniform procedures to be employed at each major parade as directed by the TPD. For example, no parking will be allowed on the parade route during the parade. We would like to request the assistance of the city in closing off the following route so as to block cars from parking in spaces. The timeline set for the requested street closures is as follows:

Saturday, July 13, 2019, 7a.m. – Staging for the parade will take place on Kansas Ave between 1st and 4th Street. The actual parade route begins at 4th and Kansas Ave., then South on Kansas in the Northbound lanes to 8th, then West on 8th to Jackson, then North on Jackson to 6th, then East on 6th back to Kansas Ave, then North on Kansas Ave back to the staging area where it will disband between 4th and 1st on Kansas.
