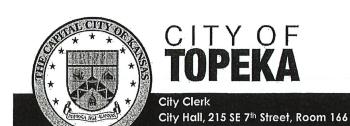

Downtown & NOTO Arts District Event Notification Requirements: Any applicant who intends to hold an event downtown or in NOTO shall use the contact information provided by the City Clerk's office upon request by the applicant. Once notification has been completed, the applicant shall execute a Statement indicating that all owners within the affected area were notified at least ten days prior to the event and shall provide such Statement to the City Clerk 48-hours prior to the event

ALL APPLICANTS SHALL CONTACT A TRAFFIC CONTROL COMPANY FOR ALL TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES, APPLICANT SHALL HAVE THE COMPANY CALL TRAFFIC ENGINEERING AT LEAST 3 DAYS PRIOR TO EVENT AND CONFIRM ORDER HAS BEEN PLACED. IF YOU ARE SUPPLYING YOUR OWN BARRICADES YOU SHALL SEND THE NCHRP 350 OR MASH COMPLIANT CERTIFICATE TO CITY OF TOPEKA TRAFFIC ENGINEERING WITH A PHOTO OF THE DEVICES NO LATER THAN 10 DAYS PRIOR TO YOUR EVENT. FAILURE TO ORDER OR USE UNAPPROVED TRAFFIC CONTROL WILL RESULT IN EVENT CANCELLATION.

If the City receives complaints related to lack of notice and deems that the notice provided was not appropriate given the particular facts and circumstances involved, approval of special event permits may be withheld in the future.

\*NOTE: The special event organizer/sponsor will be required to provide a deposit, (in an amount to be determined by designated City personnel depending upon the scale of the event). The purpose of the deposit is to ensure that normal traffic flow and access is restored to the area in a prompt manner and that the site(s) is returned to its former condition (normal wear and tear excepted). If not, the deposit will be forfeited and approval of special event permits may be withheld in the future. (1) All debris must be removed from the street(s) and/or right-of-way within thirty minutes after the ending time noted on the event permit; and (2) All other associated clean-up must be completed within 12 rs after the ending time noted on the event permit.

#### Insurance

A special event applicant is required to provide an original Certificate of Liability Insurance evidencing an insurance policy from an insurance company authorized to do business in the State of Kansas, which provides general liability coverage for any "special event" (as defined in TMC Section 12.70.010) in an amount not less than \$500,000 combined single limit per occurrence for bodily injury and property damage and which names the City of Topeka as an Additional Insured with the same coverage as the Insured, without restrictions.

Notwithstanding the above, a block party applicant may opt instead to execute an indemnity/hold harmless agreement, in a form approved by the City, which would indemnify and hold the City harmless against all claims, damages or causes of action arising from the event (see TMC Section 12.70.080).

#### **Applicant's Statement of Agreement:**

The information that I have provided herein is correct to the best of my information, knowledge and belief. I have read, understand and agree to abide by the rules and regulations included in this application and the Topeka Municipal Code, (including my obligations under the "Process and Instructions" section of this application). I further understand that any permit that may be granted is not tra ferable and is revocable at any time at the absolute discretion of the City of Topeka.
