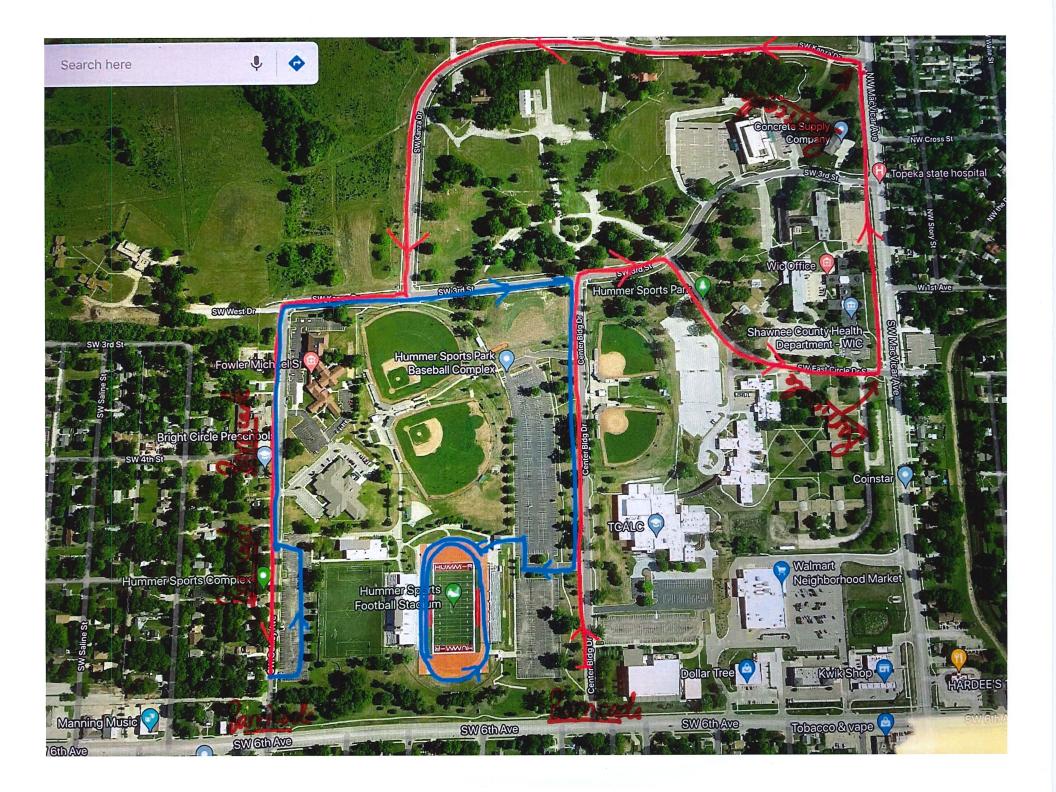

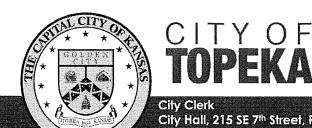

#### Angie Barry Memorial 5K Race/Walk Course Description

5 km Course (3.1 miles)

The course begins on Tuffy Kellogg Drive, adjacent West of Capital Federal Natatorium. (Other than the sidewalk along MacVicar, runners will stay on the right side of roadways throughout the course.) The course runs North to SW 3rd Street, turns right, then turns right onto SW East Circle Drive. The course will then veer left onto the sidewalk, heading North along SW MacVicar Avenue. The course will then turn left at Kanza Drive and head West on the right side of the road. Along with Kanza Drive, the course will veer to the South until it reaches 3rd street again. At this intersection, there will be an Aid Station and the course will turn right until turning left, South, onto Oakley. The course will turn left into the South Entrance of the West Parking lot and use the parking lot to circle back onto Oakley heading North. At 3rd Street, the course turns right and heads back to Tuffy Kellogg Drive, then turns South. At the parking lot entrance, the course turns right, runs to the entrance of the stadium and completes itself with one and half laps on the track.
