Call to Order. Chair Roberts called the meeting to order at 5:32 pm.

Roll Call. Present: Chair Carol Roberts; Commissioner Pamela James; Commissioner Marisol Marcelo; and Commissioner Zachary Surritt. Absent: Vice Chair Carmen Romero-Nichols; Commissioner Cynthia Hopp; Commissioner Luc Bensimon; and Commissioner Alexis Simmons.

Guests. Kristin Hammer, YWCA Representative; Ernestor De La Rosa, Chief Diversity Equity and Inclusion Officer; Zaynah Afada, Diversity Equity and Inclusion Program Coordinator; and Kaitlyn Willis, Executive Assistant to the City Manager.
